Oregonians Credit Union Reporting Fraudulent Cashier's Checks

Oregonians Credit Union is reporting fraudulent cashier's checks circulating in its name.

The fraudulent checks are being sent to individuals selling items on Craigslist or Let It Go. Right now, there is no indication that the scammer is requesting any funds be returned, but the checks are all for more than the items' selling prices on the various websites. So far, all the checks list Winston Hensley as the remitter and range from \$1,900 to \$3,400.

The fraudulent checks are light blue, bear the correct Oregonians Credit Union logo in the upper left-hand corner, and list the credit

union's correct address. A copy of the fraudulent cashier's check is displayed below.



Legitimate cashier's checks from Oregonians list the credit union's phone number and fax number under the address. Legitimate checks also have a box around the numerical dollar amount, no stars preceding the dollar amount, and contain two signature lines. Oregonians' checks also contain visible security features, such as a watermark and a fingerprint seal located in the lower, middle portion of the check.
