The undersigned Idaho financial trade associations write to express our strong support for S. 2155, the Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief and Consumer Protection Act, and urge you to support this bipartisan legislation in the U.S. House of Representatives.

S. 2155 is a carefully crafted bipartisan bill that includes commonsense improvements to the nation's financial rules that will allow community banks and credit unions to better serve their customers and communities.
